TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The following rules plus the USBC rules will govern all participants in this tournament.
2. Rule 319A. Entrants will use their highest 10-11 sanctioned league (yearbook) average based on 21 or more games. Bowlers with no 10-11 average will use 11-12 Winter League average based on 21 or more games as of December 31, 2011. No summer league averages will be used. No Lucky 13 averages. All other bowl Scratch. No YABA averages will be accepted. The 10 pin rule has been waived.
3. USBC rule 319 D and E is in effect. Bowlers who have qualified for a prize of \$600 or more in any event in a tournament which has ended within the previous 12 month period even though payment of prize has not been made, must report actual score position and amount won for possible rerating. Tournament manager reserves the right to rerate the average of any bowler whose entering average does not reflect the bowler's true ability. A bowler must report if he/she had an accumulated average in 21 or more games of tournament play in the previous 12 months (2-5-11 to 2-5-12) that exceeded the entering average by 15 pins or more.
4. Rule 319A. All bowlers will be required to initial averages as submitted as correct prior to bowling 2nd game (it shall be the bowler's responsibility to verify his or her averages). Failure to use proper averages, or to make corrections prior to bowling 2nd game, shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average, or base prize winning on submitted average is higher.
5. Rule 315. Multiple participation will be allowed, for team only. Bowlers cannot re-enter doubles and singles. No more than three bowlers on the same team may place more than once in the prize list for position standings. **THE SCORES FOR THE ALL-EVENTS WILL BE THE SCORE BOWLED ON THE ENTRY ALL-EVENTS IS PAID ON.**
6. The entrant whose name appears herein or their authorized replacement hereby agrees that the Double Diamond Invitational Tournament, its Officers, Agents, Sponsors, and Hosts shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament due to premature termination of the tournament, brought about by war, national emergency, or causes relating to or resulting from fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties, or other cause beyond the control of the Double Diamond Invitational Tournament, its Officers, Agents, Sponsors, and Host. Prize fund would be paid on a prorated basis of the entrants already bowled at the time of interruption, and there shall be no further liability.
7. Handicap: Open Division - 80% of 200, Ladies Division - 90% of 200.
8. Prize ratio: 1-20-all events, Team, Doubles and Singles 1:10 prize fund returned (100%. 90% handicap - 10% scratch). Optional scratch cash 10% and scratch monies. Non optional scratch cash only 10%.
9. Out of town bowlers will be given time preference. (100 miles or more)
10. All protests must be made to the tournament manager in writing (see USBC rule 329).
11. All reserved entries close midnight January 15, 2012; all others close Feb. 28, 2012.
12. Extra dates and times will be used if necessary with approval of USBC.
13. No entry will be accepted without total entry fees (including fees for vacancy bowler).
14. Rule 300c as written. This tournament is open to all members of USBC. There will be two divisions – one ladies only and one open division. No card holder actively bowling in any professional bowling organization will be allowed to bowl. All non-members may qualify by purchasing an associate membership card for \$21.00.
15. Substitutions are permitted upon notification. An all-event entry can be transferred if the transfer is made before either of bowlers involved have participated in any event of the tournament.
16. All averages will be verified by local association secretary.
17. Employees of the house will be allowed to bowl in the tournament and shall be eligible for all prizes. No more than three house employees on a team. No more than one house employee to a set of doubles.
18. Automatic scores are the official scores and will be downloaded directly to the computer. Any error must be reported within 24 hours, and in case of scores being lost through the computer, rebowling will be permitted.
19. In case of a tie for first place in any event, co-champions will be declared. When ties occur, the prize money will be combined and divided equally among the tied position winners.
20. Tournament manager or committee reserves the right to accept or reject any or all entries and will decide all questions arising in the tournament. Their decisions will be final – subject to appeal to USBC.
21. All changes to line up and subs must be made 30 minutes prior to start of shift time.
